**NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR UEPA PERMIT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE ELY ENERGY CENTER AND ASSOCIATED FACILITIES**

Applicants, NEVADA POWER COMPANY ("NEVADA POWER") and SIERRA PACIFIC POWER COMPANY ("SIERRA"), collectively the "Companies," through undersigned counsel, hereby files with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada ("Commission") a Notice of Intent ("Notice of Intent") to file an Application for a Permit to Construct ("UEPA Application") pursuant to the Utility Environmental Protection Act ("UEPA") set forth in NRS 704.810 to .900. The complete UEPA Application will be filed by the Companies within 30 days of the completion of the Environmental Impact Statement ("EIS") which will be prepared by the United States Bureau of Land Management ("BLM"). The UEPA application will request approval of a Permit to Construct facilities consisting of a coal fired electric generating plant, the facilities associated with the electric generating plant, 500 kV and 345 kV transmission lines, a new substation and the expansion of an existing substation ("Proposed Facilities").

**GENERAL ALLEGATIONS**

1. NEVADA POWER is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sierra Pacific Resources, a holding company incorporated under the laws of the State of Nevada.
2. NEVADA POWER provides retail electric service to the public in portions of Clark and Nye Counties and is a "public utility" as that term is defined and used in NRS 704.741 to .751 (Resource Planning).
3. NEVADA POWER's principal place of business, mailing address and telephone number are: 6226 West Sahara Avenue; P.O. Box 98910, Las Vegas, Nevada 89151; 702.367.5000.

1           4.       SIERRA is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sierra Pacific Resources, a holding  
2 company incorporated under the laws of the State of Nevada.

3           5.       SIERRA provides retail electric service to the public in northern Nevada and is  
4 a "public utility" as that term is defined and used in NRS 704.741 to .751 (Resource Planning).

5           6.       SIERRA's principal place of business, mailing address and telephone number  
6 are: 6100 Neil Road; P.O. Box 10100, Reno, Nevada 89520; 775. 834.4011.

7           7.       All correspondence related to this Notice of Intent, and the UEPA Application to  
8 be filed subsequently (copy of all pleadings, notices, orders and discovery requests), should

28           8.       The Proposed Facilities described herein will be part of the Integrated Resource  
Plan filing which NEVADA POWER is scheduled to file on July 1, 2006, as well as an  
Amendment to SIERRA's Action Plan of its 2005-2024 Integrated Resource Plan, which  
SIERRA will file by July 2006.

#### AUTHORITY

9           9.       This Notice of Intent is being submitted pursuant to the requirements of NRS  
704.870(2), including the requirement to make a filing with the Commission no "later than the  
date on which the person files with the appropriate federal agency an application for approval  
for the construction of the utility facility."

10          10.       This Notice of Intent will be followed by a UEPA Application which will allow the  
Commission to make the findings necessary to issue a Permit to Construct as set forth by the

1 requirements of the UEPA, specifically NRS 704.870 and NRS 704.890 (Grant or denial of  
2 application: Required findings; conditions and modifications); and the Commission's  
3 regulations governing construction of utility facilities (NAC 703.415 to .427) as amended, and  
4 specifically, NAC 703.420 (Application for permit); which UEPA Application will be filed in the  
5 above captioned Docket within thirty (30) days after the receipt by the Companies of the  
6 federal approval of the EIS which the Companies expect the BLM to prepare in conjunction  
7 with the federal permitting of the Proposed Facilities, as required by NRS 704.870(2)(b).  
8

### 9 **ALLEGATIONS OF MATERIAL FACTS**

10 11. Pursuant to the requirements of NRS 704.870(2)(a)(1); the Proposed Facilities  
11 can be described generally as consisting of:

12 a) an electric generating facility (the "Ely Energy Center," or "EEC"), with its  
13 associated facilities, which would be located in unincorporated White Pine County  
14 north of Ely, Nevada. It is anticipated that the EEC will be built in two phases, with the  
15 first phase consisting of two 750 megawatt (MW) units utilizing state-of-the-art, clean  
16 pulverized coal technologies, which will utilize the best proven emissions control  
17 technologies. The first unit of phase one is expected to become operational in 2011  
18 and the second within the following three years. The second phase is anticipated to  
19 consist of two 500 MW coal gasification units that will be constructed when the  
20 technology has proven to be commercially viable for the location and other parameters.  
21 The EEC, as described above, will total 2,500 MW of generating capacity;

22 b) a 500 kV switching yard located at the EEC;

23 c) two 500 kV transmission lines interconnecting the EEC with the  
24 proposed Robinson Summit substation;

25 d) the proposed Robinson Summit 500/345 kV substation which would  
26 interconnect the EEC with the existing Falcon to Gondor 345 kV transmission line, and  
27 which would be located in unincorporated White Pine County;  
28

1 e) the proposed Harry Allen to Robinson Summit 500 kV transmission line,  
2 which would cross portions of unincorporated White Pine, Lincoln and Clark Counties;  
3 and

4 f) a proposed expansion of the existing Harry Allen substation to  
5 accommodate the interconnection of the proposed Harry Allen to Robinson Summit  
6 500 kV transmission line.

7 12. Pursuant to the requirements of NRS 704.870(2)(a)(2); an EIS, required by the  
8 National Environmental Policy Act ("NEPA"), will be prepared by the BLM during the federal  
9 permitting process for the Proposed Facilities.

10 13. This Notice of Intent is being filed with respect to the Proposed Facilities  
11 described herein due to the fact that the EIS has not yet been produced, in addition to the fact  
12 that final routing and construction parameters remain dependant on the outcome of the federal  
13 NEPA process. Therefore, it is impossible for the Companies to provide information at this  
14 time adequate to satisfy the requirements of NAC 703.420.

15 14. Following the completion of the federal NEPA process, the Companies will be  
16 able to provide the Commission with a UEPA Application that fully complies with the relevant  
17 requirements of the NRS and the NAC.

18 15. Regarding Proof of Service, a copy of the application has been served on the  
19 clerk of each local government affected by the location(s) pursuant to NRS 704.870(2)(a) and  
20 NRS 704.874(4)(a) (see Certificate of Service list located in Attachment A).

21 16. Regarding Public Notice, proof of publication of a summary of the Notice of  
22 Intent has appeared in newspapers published and distributed in the area where the Proposed  
23 Facilities is proposed to be located pursuant to NRS 704.870(4)(b) and NAC 703.420(e) (see  
24 Attachment B).

25 17. The State Environmental Commission is designated as a party to this  
26 proceeding, pursuant to NRS 704.885(1)(b) and will be served a copy of this Notice of Intent  
27 pursuant to NRS 704.870(3) simultaneously with this filing.

**PRAYER FOR RELIEF**



Determine that the Companies have acted properly in submitting this Notice of Intent, as required by NRS 704.870(2)(a), in consideration of the inability of the Companies to submit a complete UEPA Application until after the federal NEPA process has been completed, at which time the Companies will file a complete UEPA Application pursuant to NRS 704.870(2)(b) and all applicable NAC sections;

C. Grant such deviations from the Commission's regulations as may be in the public interest; and

D. Grant the Companies such other and further relief as the Commission may find reasonable and appropriate under the circumstances.

Then if granted, the Companies may recover all costs prudently and reasonably incurred in carrying out the UEPA permit to construct.

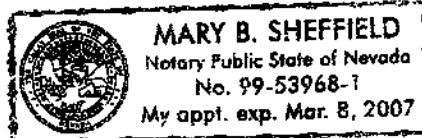

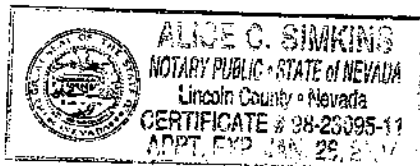

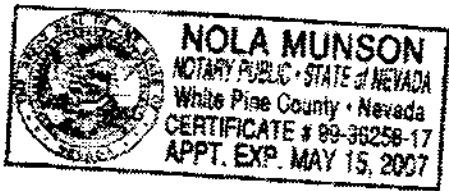
